CAN YOU IMAGINE?

Can you imagine? Will you get yourself deceived? Do you really believe what you see? Are you sure you can see everything and miss nothing? Welcome to the reality where nothing is obvious and clear at a glance. Welcome to the universes where it is easy to get lost, if only you let yourself be taken off guard for a while. Meet the artists who are going to test your imagination!

Joan Fontcuberta, Augustin Rebetez, Noémie Goudal, Martin Kollar all say: do not believe, but instead doubt, ask, be an inquisitive and attentive observer, do not trust photography. Under the joint banner: Can you imagine? we present four different projects. What they share is their special language, which mixes fiction and reality – in order to question the credibility of the medium, tell us about the non-material reality or direct our attention to the absurdities of everyday life. All these artists make the same gesture towards the audience – they invite us to participate in the show. With various strategies and esthetics, the artists and curators pose challenges to us and force us to take a closer look at every single picture and the context in which it is presented. At the same time, they prove that the form which employs fiction, though seemingly separated from the reality, tells us more about this reality than some documentaries.

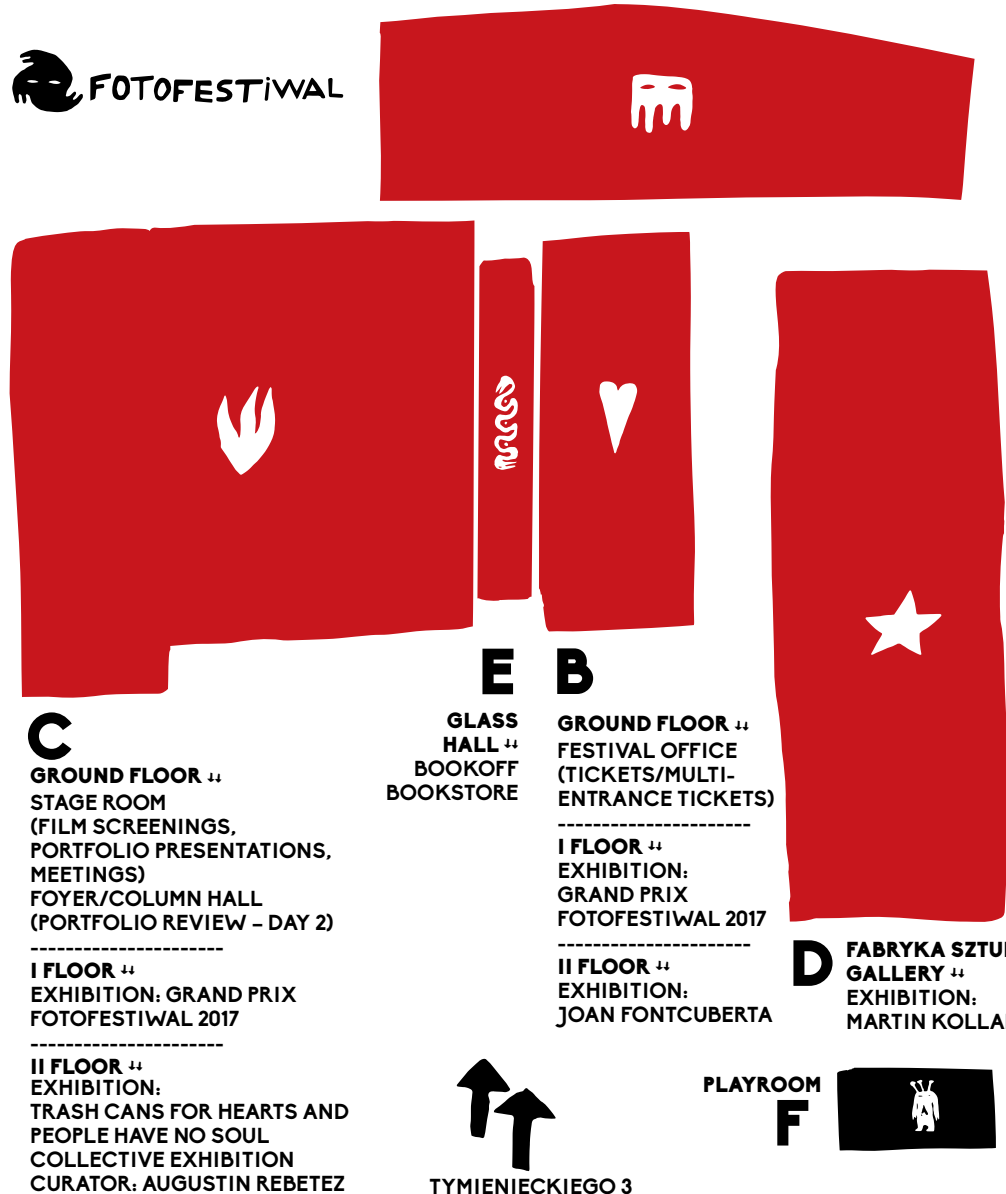

CAN YOU IMAGINE?

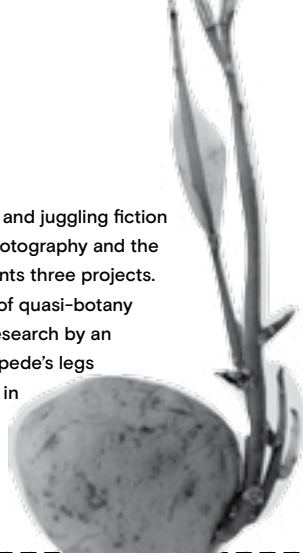
An exhibition of works created by a classical master of artistic deception and juggling fiction and reality. For many years, he has been questioning the credibility of photography and the media, provoking and testing our habits and beliefs. The exhibition presents three projects.

Herbarium and *Constellations* will introduce you into the fantastic world of quasi-botany and pseudo-astronomy. *Fauna* is a seemingly documentary project on research by an unknown biologist, who discovers new animal species. A snake with centipede's legs and a monkey with a horse's torso are just examples of what you can find in this bestiary.

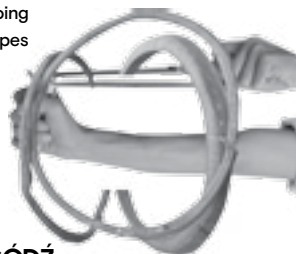

THE ENERGY OF TIME – 110 YEARS OF THE POWER INDUSTRY IN ŁÓDŹ

A music and visual spectacle which will take us to the 1920s and 1930s in Łódź. Magnificent light and sound effects will be a great background for animated photographs from the exceptional Veolia Archive. Thanks to them, we will see the industrial Łódź and the first heat and power plant EC1, as it changed to become an integral element of the urban landscape. All that was scrupulously documented by Wiktor Jekimenko in the priceless collection of over 2000 glass negatives, which are gradually revealed to us.

This year's Berlinale hit, which received a standing ovation every time it was presented during the famous film festival. A documentary adaptation of an unfinished novel by James Baldwin, one of the most influential African-American writers and thinkers. Using Baldwin's original words (voiced by Samuel L. Jackson) and a flood of rich archival material (including photographs), Raoul Peck created a radical, up-to-the-minute examination of the issue of race in America.

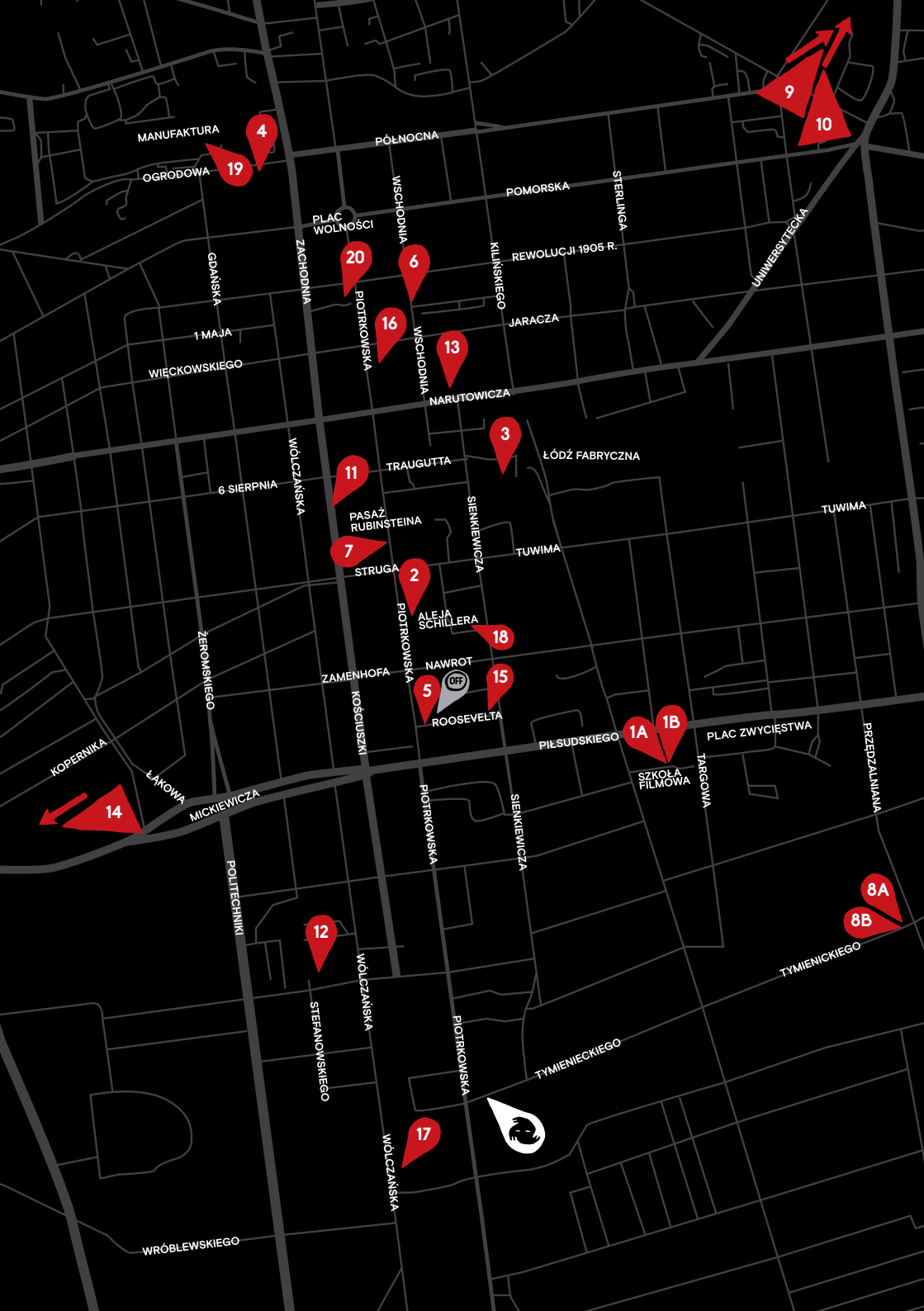
